Camp Descriptions

Painting the Community

Explore the art of mural painting!

June 24 – July 12, 2019 (3 weeks)

As a team, participants will develop a concept for a mural that they will paint locally. This camp includes basic drawing and painting techniques, lessons in preparing artwork for large-scale installation, and finally, painting the design on the exterior of a building. Come and be involved with an art experience few people get to do!

Fashion Design Camp

Discover the world of fashion!

July 15 – August 2, 2019 (3 weeks)

Participants will learn about the complete fashion design process as they are provided samplings of:

- > Fashion sketching
- > T-shirt de-construction
- > Hand-sewing
- > Machine-sewing
- > Adobe digital skills
- > Paint on fabric
- > Crafts
- > Embroidery
- > Embellishments
- > Fashion show!

Examples of previous projects include: tie-dyeing a silk scarf, exploring Photoshop, designing a bag (making a pattern, picking a fabric and sewing a bag), and painting shoes to create a custom look.

Art of Architecture

Explore architecture and design!

July 15 – August 2, 2019 (3 weeks)

Experiment with 3-D printing and laser cutting, cutting-edge software, and explore architecture through traditional and digital hand drawing and model making. Students are introduced to design through model-making and drawing, an LA architecture field trip, outdoor sketching walks through our beautiful campus, and presentations and group discussions. Projects from previous summers include building a group city model, designing building components using digital fabrication tools, constructing a bridge and testing its strength, and drawing a house using digital software.
