Four benchmarks:

Prior to entry, the student states a research area of interest within an established area within the School of Architecture.

At completion of Semester 1:  
Student presents a clearly defined thesis statement, with case studies, literature/policy review, and design-policy hypothesis.

At completion of Semester 2:  
Student presents experimental design and policy recommendations for critical review .

At completion of Semester 3:  
Student synthesizes and presents design/policy recommendations for public dissemination.
